## EISENHOWER BIRTHPLACE

In Denison, Eisenhower Birthplace State Historic Site showcases the home where the 34th U.S. President Dwight D. Eisenhower was born in 1890. Antique furniture fills the frame house, demonstrating the working class life of the Eisenhowers. The visitors center celebrates “Ike” with memorabilia and exhibits highlighting his many accomplishments. A statue and picnic pavilion round out the place where everything started for the first Texas-born president.
